Applicants must be a graduating high school senior without regard to race, sex, religion, or financial need. Scholarships are non-renewable and selections made by the Scholarship Committee are final. Selection will be based on:

- School transcript which includes grades, GPA, and class rank (transcript may be mailed directly from school to Connie's Frozen Custard, 12545 Jones Rd., Houston, Texas 77070)
- Completed application along with 650-1000 word typed essay creating a new frozen custard concrete "flavor"

Announcements of the scholarship awardees will be made in **MAY 2023**, via the email address included in the application. Only the applicants selected to receive a scholarship will be notified.

The awardees must respond in writing to accept the scholarship by the date in their notification letter.

The scholarship recipients must provide a copy of the letter of acceptance to the school they plan to attend after high school graduation prior to receipt of scholarship.

Students must submit the following documents. **Each document must be labeled with your First and Last Name.**

Submitted applications that are not in compliance with these instructions will not be reviewed.

- Essay (typed)
